Dear Supervisors,

I am writing in behalf of Marin Conservation League to add our provisional support for Project Homekey, the County's proposal to convert the senior care facility at 1251 S. Eliseo into permanent supportive housing for the homeless. MCL has not yet studied the proposal in detail, but on first glance, can see all the earmarks of an environmentally responsible solution to a demonstrated housing need. Re-purposing existing buildings is always more environmentally sustainable than new construction. Furthermore, the new use would likely have minimum impact on the surrounding community, and at the same time would provide residents easy access to open space and passive recreation.

MCL urges you to take the first steps toward acquiring this property by authorizing a feasibility study. Such a study will inform both the Board and the public of the benefits and any potential pitfalls before advancing the proposal.
